Antrodiopsis Audet, gen.nov.

It differs from *Antrodia* s. str. by basidiomata perennial, by habitus only resupinate, by basidia smaller, 10-14 x 4-6 µm and by uninucleated spores.

Holotype : *Poria oleracea* R.W. Davidson & Lombard 1947.

Comment: The new genus is supported by the molecular analyses in Ortiz-Santana et al. 2013 (*Mycologia* 105 (6): 1391-1411). The latin words are verified by Jean-Marie Pirlot and acknowledged here.

Etymology : *Antrodiopsis* – genus similar to *Antrodia*.
